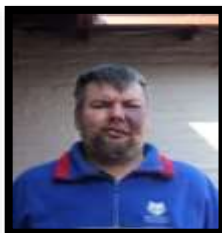

We had fun in the woods learning to become great marksmen.




